

## **Outstanding Contribution to the Community Awards 2023**

- 1 The Outstanding Contribution to the Community Award is a tribute to a member of the community and confers no material honours or special privileges.
- Those qualifying for the Outstanding Contribution award should be considered to have undertaken outstanding service to the community.
- Any resident of Blakeney may be nominated for the award although nominees who do not have residential qualification will be considered at the Parish Council's discretion.
- Nominations should be submitted using the application form/or in writing to the Parish Clerk the nominee having been **proposed and seconded by two Blakeney residents or those with an interest in the village i.e. business/employment/community group leader or similar.** Proposers cannot be a relative of the nominee. Verbal applications will not be accepted.
- Nominations must be submitted via the form or in writing by Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Nominations received after this date will not be considered.
- The nominations will be presented to Councillors and the recipient(s) of the award(s) will be decided upon by the Full Council on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2023.
- 7 Serving members of the Parish Council are not eligible for the award, but are eligible to propose or second nominations.
- Presentation of the award will be made at The Party on The Pastures on Sunday 20th August by either an invited Guest or by The Chairman of Blakeney Parish Council.
- 9 The recipient(s) will receive a framed certificate and vouchers from ADNAMS to be exchanged at The White Horse, here in Blakeney.
- 10 The Council will actively promote this award each year in order to ensure a good number of nominations are received.
